

North Simcoe Muskoka Local Health Integration Network, Home and Community Care Nursing Clinics



In partnership with Closing The Gap Healthcare, Bayshore Home Health, and Saint Elizabeth, the North Simcoe Muskoka Local Health Integration Network (LHIN) provides nursing care to members of the community through community clinics in the region. In support of timely access to care, patients can access community nursing clinics seven days a week, during daytime and evening hours, with flexibility to schedule appointments at times convenient to them.

What are the benefits of attending a nursing clinic?

- Appointments are scheduled in advance and patients will experience timely access to care to limit disruption to their normal routine.
- Clinic nurses are experts in intravenous therapy, wound care, and other nursing treatments.
- With consent, nurses will speak with a patient's primary care provider to address any concerns that may arise.

How is a nursing clinic different from a medical walk-in clinic?

- NSM LHIN community nursing clinics are only open to patients receiving Home and Community Care services. They are not 'open to the public.'
- Community nursing clinics are covered by OHIP.
- There is no physician on site.
- There are no 'walk-in' appointments. All visits are scheduled in advance at a time convenient to the patient.

Community Nursing Clinic Appointments:

All patients (adults and youth) receiving Home and Community Care nursing services will receive care at a community nursing clinic. A member of the North Simcoe Muskoka LHIN Home and Community Care team will make the referral to the clinic and the clinic will call the patient to book an appointment. If a nursing clinic is not an appropriate treatment location or available in the area a patient resides, the patient will be contacted directly and an alternate care setting will be arranged.

Patients are provided with a phone number to contact the nursing clinic should an appointment need to be changed; a minimum 24-hour notification is requested. Patients are to bring identification and their OHIP (health card) to all appointments.
