

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

Current State of Long-Term Care by Bed Type





October to December 2020




The median age for residents in the Central area long-term care homes is 87, one year younger than the provincial average (December 2020).

October to December 2020




Similar to other areas in Ontario, more than two-thirds of the residents in Central long-term care homes are female and less than one-third are male residents.

Percentage of Patients Admitted with High or Very High MAPLe Scores




- Central has the 5th highest complexity of patients placed into Long-Term Care in the province

Median wait time by bed types




Median: the mid-point of the days waited for admission to LTC. Half the applicants admitted to LTC were placed into accommodations within the median number of days, and half the applicants waited longer.

Factors that could impact wait times include: Gender, vacancy turnover, accommodation type, secure vs non-secure bed type, applicant's care needs







Profile of Patients on LTC Wait List

- Over 99% of patients on the current waitlist have triggered positive in the Cognitive Performance Scale on the RAI-HC Assessment. This is an increase of 18% since 2019
- Cognitive Performance Scale (CPS): This scale describes the cognitive status of a patient. Higher scores indicate more severe cognitive impairment

Cummer Lodge Behavioural Support Unit

- Established in April 2012, Cummer Lodge Behavioural Support Unit is a 16-bed specialized unit in Cummer Lodge Long-Term Care Home
- It is a transitional unit that offers assessment and support to identify and address responsive behaviours caused by dementia, major mental health issues or neurological disorders






North York Central Area

- Beds: 1,597 beds (8 LTCHs)
- Beds needed in the next 5 years: 1,110 beds
- Homes for redevelopment: 6 homes
- Beds for redevelopment: 1,000 beds
- Currently, **1,414 patients residing in this area** are waiting to be placed in any long-term care home
- **English, Chinese and Russian** are the top 3 preferred languages of the 1,414 patients residing in this area waiting for long term care
- In 2020/21, **243 patients residing in this area** were admitted to any long-term care home
- Currently, **969 patients living in Ontario** are waiting for 1 of the 8 LTC homes in this region as their first choice




North York West Area

- Beds: 1,835 beds (9 LTCHs)
- Needed in the next 5 years: 0 beds
- Homes for redevelopment: 5 homes
- Beds for redevelopment: 982 beds
- Currently, **734 patients residing in this area** are waiting to be placed in any long-term care home
- **English, Italian and Portuguese** are the top 3 preferred languages of the 734 patients residing in this area waiting for long term care
- In 2020/21, **235 patients residing in this area** were admitted to a long-term care home
- Currently, **888 patients living in Ontario** are waiting for 1 of 9 LTC homes in this region as their first choice



Western York Region Area


- Beds: 1,348 (11 LTCHs)
- Needed in the next 5 years: 1,004 beds
- Homes for redevelopment: 2 homes
- Beds for redevelopment: 64 beds
- Currently, **1,353 patients residing in this area** are waiting to be placed in any long-term care home
- **English, Chinese and Italian** are the top 3 preferred languages of the 1,353 patients residing in this area waiting for long term care
- In 2020/21, **293 patients residing in this area** were admitted to a long-term care home
- Currently, **2,521 patients living in Ontario** are waiting for 1 of 12 LTC homes in this region as their first choice

Eastern York Region Area

- Beds: 1,337 beds (8 LTCHs)
- Needed in the next 5 years: 818 beds
- Homes for redevelopment: 1 home
- Beds for redevelopment: 31 beds
- Currently, 1,213 patients residing in this area are waiting to be placed in a long-term care home
- Chinese (Cantonese and Mandarin), English and Chinese (Yue) are the top 3 preferred languages of the 1,213 patients residing in this area waiting for long term care
- In 2020/21, 206 patients residing in this area were admitted to a long-term care home
- Currently, 1,302 patients living in Ontario are waiting for 1 of 7 LTC homes in this region as their first choice

Northern York Region Area

- Beds: 1,017 (8 LTCHs)
- Needed in the next 5 years: 0 beds
- Homes for redevelopment: 5 homes
- Beds for redevelopment: 537 beds
- Currently, 700 patients residing in this area are waiting to be placed in any long-term care home
- English, Chinese and Italian are the top 3 preferred languages of the 700 patients residing in this area waiting for long term care
- In 2020/21, 141 patients residing in this area were admitted to a long-term care home
- Currently, 915 patients living in Ontario are waiting for 1 of 8 LTC homes in this region as their first choice

- Currently, **321 patients residing in this area** are waiting to be placed in any long-term care home
- **English, Italian and Portuguese** are the top 3 preferred languages of the 321 patients residing in this area waiting for long term care
- In 2020/21, **53 patients residing in this area** were admitted to a long-term care home
- Currently, **448 patients living in Ontario** are waiting for 1 of 2 LTC homes in this region as their first choice

- An estimated 228 to 2,096 LTC beds would be needed in the undersupplied sub-regions to be on par with the Central Region's average of 51 per 1,000 75+ population
- To bring the bed ratios up to par with the province, between 281 and 2,590 additional long-stay beds are needed
