## Community Nursing Clinics

### What are the benefits of attending a nursing clinic?

- We will work with you to schedule an appointment that best suits your needs so that you experience timely access to care
- Clinics are staffed with highly qualified nursing teams with expertise in IV therapy, wound care and other nursing treatments
- Most clinics are open 12 hours a day, seven days a week and offer a variety of appointment times
- Supplies are available at the clinic, so you do not need to worry about being home for a delivery or finding a place to store supplies
- Our five clinics are conveniently located in areas to best serve you i.e., bus routes, parking



Home and Community Care Support Services Mississauga Halton provides nursing care at five clinics within our region. Our clinic partners are Acclaim Health, Closing the Gap, Spectrum Healthcare and Bayshore Home Health.

Community nursing clinics are staffed with highly qualified teams of health professionals specializing in wound care and other nursing services, such as IV therapy.

Our clinics are open seven days a week, and offer day and evening appointments to best suit your needs or the needs of a loved one you support.

### What is the difference between a nursing clinic and a walk-in clinic?

- You must be assessed by Home and Community Care Support Services Mississauga Halton with a need for nursing care in order to attend a nursing clinic; clinics are not “open to the public”
- Visits to a nursing clinic are by appointment only; clinics do not accept walk-ins
- Nursing clinics are staffed by qualified, experienced nursing teams; there are no physicians onsite
- Nursing clinics are for patients assessed for our care and are covered by OHIP

## Your clinic appointment



Once your appointment is made, it is important that you attend any scheduled appointments so that your care needs are met.

You will be provided with a phone number to contact should you need to cancel or change your appointment. A minimum of 24 hours notification is required. Please be sure to bring identification and your OHIP health card to your appointment.

Our five nursing clinics are accessible by bus, taxi or car. If you require transportation support, your care coordinator will help identify options in the community.
