

The fundamentals of hospice palliative care Fall 2023 online or in-person classes

Fundamentals core

Fundamentals core education is a six-week certificate program for **ALL** health care providers and volunteers who wish to enhance knowledge and develop capacity related to hospice palliative care.

Fundamentals eligibility

- Health care provider or volunteer caring for people with a progressive, life-limiting illnesses
- Access to an internet-enabled computer
- Knowledge of basic computer programs

Included in the core curriculum

- Three online OR in-person classroom sessions (case-based learning)
- Eight e-learning modules
- Two peer-to-peer exchanges (Peers will be assigned)
- One reflective activity

Fundamentals enhanced

Fundamentals enhanced is education for nurses (RN/RPN/NP) who have completed the Fundamentals core and wish to further develop their capacity related to hospice palliative care. Enhanced is a prerequisite for comprehensive advanced palliative care education program. This additional program includes (at no additional cost):

- Two additional chapters to be read
- Two additional e-learning modules
- One (either online or in-person) mentor session with a local palliative care consultant
