BOARD MEETING HIGHLIGHTS June 27, 2017

The following are highlights from the Open Board Meeting of the Erie St. Clair Local Health Integration Network (ESC LHIN):

Agenda Item	Highlights
Open Mic	The ESC LHIN Board of Directors and senior staff heard from three presenters from the community:
	1) Denise Dodman, Interim Executive Director, from the Chatham-Kent Hospice; she provided an update on the hospice's success after a full year in service. The Chatham-Kent Hospice has seen over 211 residents to-date, has over 200 volunteers, as well as a full team of clinical and administrative staff. Since opening their doors, the Chatham-Kent Hospice has developed three new strategic goals:
	 Ensure quality compassionate care Transparent, accountable, efficient management of resources Partner to build the system capacity to support end-of-life care
	ESC LHIN Board of Directors commended the Chatham-Kent Hospice on their important work and a successful first year in operation.
	2) Dr. Tony Hammer, Addiction Specialist Physician with the Erie St. Clair Methadone Clinic; he expressed his concerns regarding the "opioid epidemic" across the Erie St. Clair region. He shared that in one county alone, we have exceeded the provincial average for accidental deaths due to drug overdose. He discussed opportunities for an integrated system to address people suffering from addictions by determining the most effective approach for each unique patient, while keeping in mind best practices based on proven approaches.
	3) Gael Fisher, Chief Administration with the Erie St. Clair Clinic; she expressed her concerns regarding the delivery of addictions services and the difference between abstinence-based and harm reduction approaches.
	ESC LHIN Board of Directors agreed that the issues we are seeing now with addictions is a major challenge and something we are certainly focusing on. ESC LHIN CEO, Ralph Ganter, confirmed that statistics have showed that our LHIN is the worst in the province in terms of prescribed opioids. While work is already underway to address these issues, opportunities were discussed for the future ESC LHIN VP of Clinical to facilitate the development of an effective approach in regards to addictions. ESC LHIN promised to follow-up with Dr. Hammer and Ms. Fisher as we work through this process.

Charlotte Eleanor Englehart Hospital of Bluewater Health / Town of Petrolia: Community Integration Capital Project

ESC LHIN Board of Directors heard a presentation from the following stakeholders in regards to a new collaboration project with the Town of Petrolia and Charlotte Eleanor Englehart Hospital (CEEH) of Bluewater Health:

The community partners have come together to create a shared vision of a "Health Care Village" in the town of Petrolia. In regards to a Hospital Master Plan for the CEEH of Bluewater Health, the objectives of the plan are to:

- Assess the physical condition of the CEEH
- 2. Analyze service and health care needs for the surrounding community
- 3. Identify capital investments to improve hospital operations, efficiency, and service over the long-term

A Joint Steering Committee was formed, with membership from the community, local health care system, as well as the Town of Petrolia. To date, the committee has organized several open houses to engage the community on the proposed plans.

Bluewater Health is currently in Stage 1A of the Capital Planning Process for this project; next steps include ESC LHIN Board review in September for the approval of both Stage 1A and 1B for submission to the MOHLTC.
