

South West LHIN Board Highlights – September 16, 2014 Meeting

The South West LHIN Board of Directors held its monthly meeting on Tuesday, September 16th at Alexandra Hospital, Ingersoll. There were 10 members of the public in attendance.

Meeting Highlights

- The Board received a presentation on the creation of a Long-Term Care Home Specialized Unit for People with Acquired Brain Injuries by Sue Hillis, Dale Brain Injury Services, Leslie DuCharme, Kensington Village and Anita Cole, South West CCAC. The South West LHIN approved funding for the 14 bed specialized unit at its September 2013 board meeting.
- The Board approved the final 2014/2015 South West LHIN Annual Business Plan for submission to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care.
- The Board received an information update on the 2014/2015 Priorities for Investment (PFI) Plan. The board reviewed the short-listed PFI plan priorities currently under consideration and discussed the targeted investment approach versus an across-the-board increase.
- Information was provided to the Board on the South West LHIN Report on Performance Scorecard and Ministry-LHIN Performance Agreement Dashboard for the 2014/15 First Quarter.

Following the Board Meeting, The Oxford Health Services Information & Discussion Session took place from 6:00 to 8:30 pm at St. James Anglican Church in Ingersoll with 64 people in attendance. The evening focused on Health Links implementation in Oxford County. Presentations included:
