## **Comprehensive Advanced Hospice Palliative Care Program (CAPCE) Application – Fall 2023**

Comprehensive Advanced Palliative Care Education (CAPCE) Program combines the "art" and "science" of Hospice Palliative Care (HPC) for nurses (RN/RPN/NP).

The program embeds best practice standards and aligns with the Model to Guide Hospice Palliative Care.

CAPCE focuses on the development and role of the nurse as an HPC resource for the inter-professional team in long-term care homes, agencies, hospitals, and communities.

## Components of CAPCE include:

- Self-directed reading and reflection
- 6 e-learning modules
- 4 case-based learning MS Teams sessions, 4 hours each. Attendance at ALL four sessions mandatory!
- 4 peer-to-peer exchanges (learning debrief)
- 2 practical application assignments
- 6 individual or small group coaching sessions, 2 hours
- 3-4 hours per week of study, 5 months in length
